





Reporting our Impact

Highlights of the 2024 Sustainability Report:

• Carbon Emissions Reduced by 15% Per Attendee

Despite a 22% growth in attendance, ReThink HK 2024 cut emissions per attendee by **15%** (vs. 2023) and **46%** (vs. 2021 baseline year), showcasing progress toward net-zero goals.

• 150 Tonnes of Carbon Offset Locally

Partnered with **Kadoorie Farm & Botanic Garden** to sequester **150,000 kg CO₂e** through a sponsored biochar programme and tree planting — exceeding event emissions to host a carbon-neutral event, while supporting Hong Kong's biodiversity.

• Pioneering Sustainable Events with Better Stands

Piloted the **Better Stands Initiative**, **43%** of raw-space exhibitors achieved "**Gold Standard**" for reusable/recyclable booths.

• Net-Zero Roadmap – Setting Targets

- By 2026 reduce emissions per attendee by **50% vs. 2021 baseline**
- Cut **plastic wrap usage by 15%** for 2025
- Reduce **recycling contamination by 50%** for 2025

• Community Impact & Youth Empowerment

HK\$450,000 of delegate fees funded NGO impact projects and capacity-building programmes through the **ReThink Foundation**, and engaged **143 students** via internship and volunteer programs.
