# Objectives

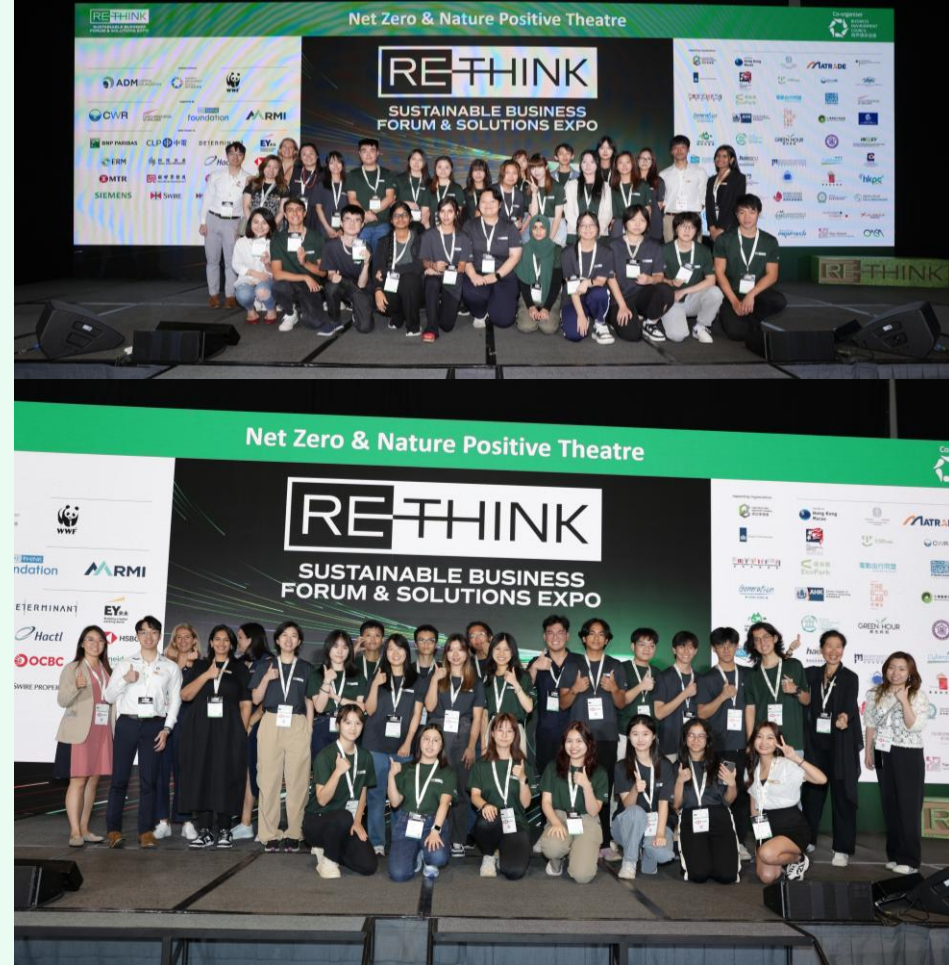
- Provide university students with a first-person experience in B2B sustainability event

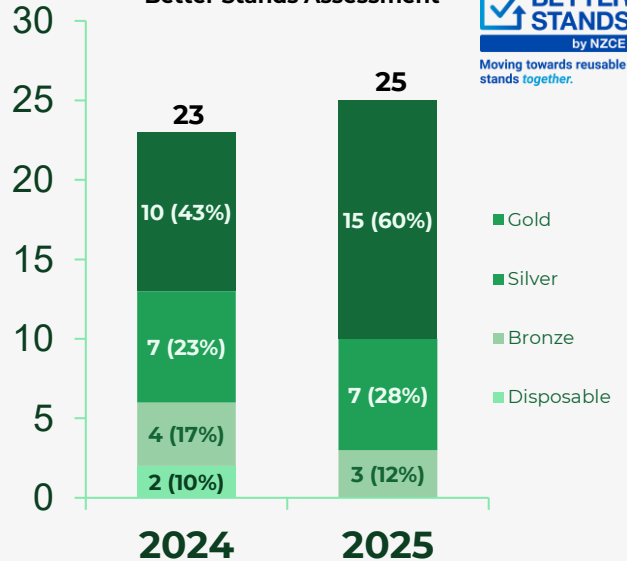

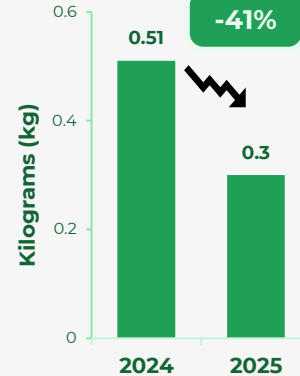

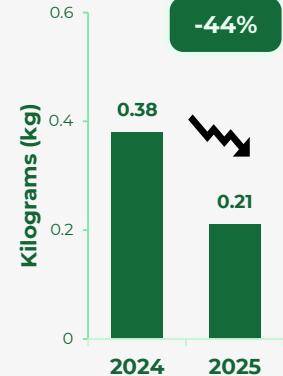
